

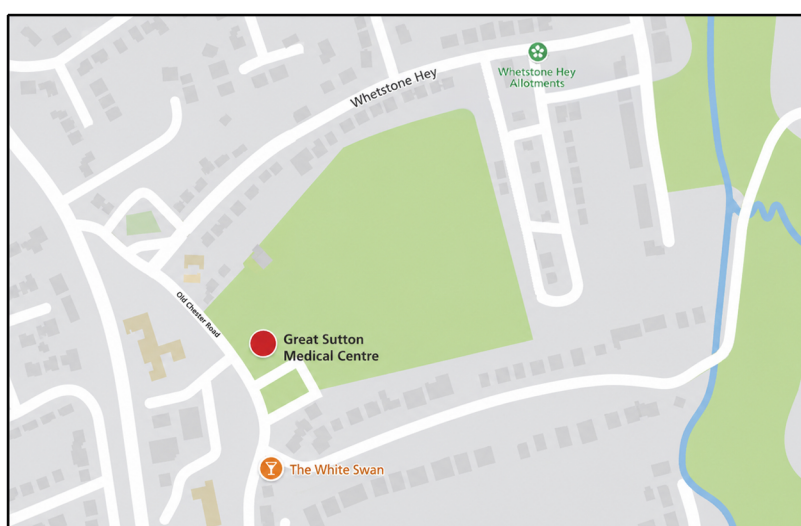
Great Sutton Healthy Living Centre - Site Map

Travelling by car from Wirral

The most direct route is via the M53 motorway, exiting at Junction 8, approximately 2-3 miles from Great Sutton Healthy Living Centre. From the junction, follow the A41 towards Ellesmere Port and then local roads to Old Chester Road, Great Sutton, CH66 3NZ. The journey from most areas of the Wirral takes approximately 15–30 minutes, depending on traffic.

Travelling by car from Chester

Great Sutton Healthy Living Centre is approximately 8 miles from Chester. Follow the A41 north towards Ellesmere Port, then continue onto local roads to Old Chester Road, Great Sutton, CH66 3NZ. The journey typically takes 15-20 minutes, depending on traffic.

Travelling from the M53

The nearest motorway access is M53 Junction 8, which is approximately 2-3 miles from the centre. From the junction, follow the A41 towards Ellesmere Port and then local roads to Old Chester Road. The journey from the motorway takes approximately 5-10 minutes, depending on traffic.

Travelling by bus

The nearest bus stops are Bulls Head (approximately a 1-2 minute walk) and Whetstone Hey (approximately a 2-3 minute walk). Buses include: 1, 6, 6A, 23 and 23S.

Travelling by train

The nearest railway stations are Hooton (8 minutes by car) and Little Sutton (3 minutes by car).

Accessibility and Visitor Information

Great Sutton Healthy Living Centre has step-free access to the main entrance and accessible parking is available on site, including designated Blue Badge parking bays. A patient drop-off point is located close to the entrance for those requiring assistance.
