

Alcohol Gel... how, when and why.



- Alcohol gel is a quick and convenient method of hand decontamination if used appropriately:
 - when hands are visibly clean
 - when the alcohol gel covers all surfaces of the hands by thoroughly rubbing hands together
 - by ensuring a supply of alcohol gel is available at the point of care/use
- Alcohol gel must not be used when:
 - hands are soiled or visibly dirty
 - following exposure to body fluids
 - when caring for patients/residents with vomiting/diarrhoeal illness and Clostridium difficile
