

Sound cue pictures



This sound is represented by a bubble wand which blows bubbles. To make this sound, put lips together and then **puff** air away. Use index finger as if to pop bubbles.



This sound is represented by a ball bouncing. To make this sound, put lips together and then release as for p but with added voice. Use hand to gesture bouncing ball.



This sound is represented by water dripping from a tap. To make this sound, put the tongue just behind the top teeth and release. Use index finger to motion water dripping from a tap.



This sound is represented by the banging of a drum. To make this sound, as for t but with added voice. Use two fingers to motion banging a drum.




This sound is represented by **m** for chocolate bar. To make this sound, put lips together and say mm. Use hand to motion rubbing your tummy.




This sound is represented by a clown's nose. To make this sound, put tongue just behind the top teeth and say **nn**. Use index finger to press tip of nose.
























This sound is represented by a key turning in a lock. To make this sound, the tongue is raised at the back and is down at the front. The back of the tongue touches the palate and is then released. It may help if you hold the tongue tip down with a finger/spatula. Hold index finger against opposite palm and twist as though turning a key in the lock.



This sound is represented by a gorilla banging his chest. To make this sound, as for k but with added voice. Use your fist to gently pat your chest.



This sound is represented by the sound Freddy rabbit makes with his big front teeth. To make this sound, the top teeth rest on the lower and air is then gently blown out. Place index finger against lips and move forward as if being blown away.



This sound is represented by a hissing snake. To make this sound, put teeth together, the tongue is placed just behind the top teeth and air is blown. Waggle the index finger forward away from the lips.



This sound is represented by a girl placing a finger in front of the lips and indicating be quiet. To make this sound, lips pushed forward and air blown forward and out. Place the index finger against lips as you blow.



This sound is represented by a lolly. To make this sound, imagine something is stuck at the back of your teeth and try to push it off. Use the thumb as if licking a lolly ice.
