You were given sedation to help with your treatment, it can make you feel drowsy or tired.



For the next 24 hours you **SHOULD**:



Be taken home by your escort in a car or taxi. A responsible adult needs to look after you.





Relax for the rest of the day.



If you have any children, elderly or sick relatives you might normally look after, ask someone to do this for you.



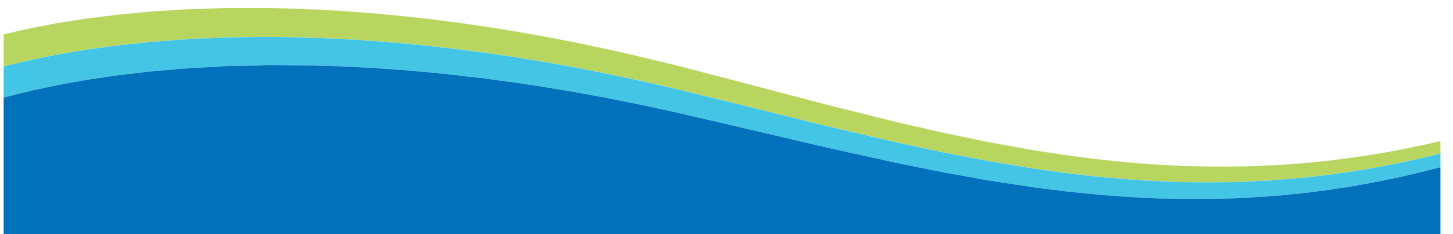
Take your regular prescribed medication as usual.



For the next 24 hours you **SHOULD NOT:**



Exercise, drive or ride a bike, your insurance would be invalid.





Climb ladders.



Use machinery - including things at home such as irons, kettles etc.



Make important decisions or sign business or legal documents.



Go to work.



Drink alcohol or use drugs.
