

Poster competition - terms and conditions

0-19 + Health and Wellbeing Service is delivered by Wirral Community Health and Care NHS Foundation Trust in partnership with Cheshire East Council.

"Trust" means Wirral Community Health and Care NHS Foundation Trust, St Catherine's Health Centre, Derby Road, Birkenhead, Wirral, CH42 0LQ.

"ChatHealth" is a text messaging service for children and young people by which school nurses provide confidential health and wellbeing advice.

- 1. As part of the ChatHealth launch in Cheshire East the Trust is hosting a poster competition for children and young people across the local area. The winning posters from each age category will be used to promote the new text messaging service when it is launched on Monday 1 February 2021.
- 2. Entrants must read the competition full terms and conditions. Failure to do this will result in dismissal from the competition.
- 3. Entry to the competition is free.
- 4. The competition is open to Cheshire East residents aged 11-19 years
- 5. There are three age related categories
 - 11-14 years
 - 15-16
 - 17-19 years
- 6. There will be a winner and runner up from each age related category.
- 7. Each winner and runner up will receive a certificate and voucher.
- 8. Vouchers are non-transferrable and not for resale. Vouchers cannot be redeemed for cash.
- 9. The competition closing date has been extended to Friday 5 March 2021.
- 10. Entries received after midnight Friday 5 March 2021 will not be entered into the competition.
- 11. Late, illegible, incomplete, defaced or corrupt entries will not be accepted. Entries must not be sent through agencies or third parties.
- 12. Submission of entries:

- 13. All entrants under the age of 16 must submit their photograph of their poster with a signed entry form from their parent, guardian or carer. Entry forms are available at <u>www.wirralct.nhs.uk/poster</u> and included in the briefing pack. You can also request an entry form by emailing <u>wcnt.communications@nhs.net</u>
- 14. All emails must also include the following information:
 - name
 - age
 - contact telephone number
- 15. It is not the responsibility of the Trust to follow up entries without signed entry forms.
- 16. The winner will be notified by contact telephone number / email and announced on both the Trust and Cheshire East Council website and social media platforms (Twitter and Facebook).
- 17. The winners and runners up may be required to take part in publicity.
- 18. Copyright of all images submitted as part of this competition remains with the respective entrants.
- 19. Each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to the Trust to feature any or all of the submitted artwork/images in any of their publications, their websites and/or in any promotional material connected to this competition. Artwork/images will only be used by the Trust for a period of one (1) year (19 February 2021 19 February 2022).
- 20. Posters submitted must be the work of the individual submitting them and must not have been published elsewhere or have won a prize in any other competition. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any artwork/images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws. Entrants must warrant that any photograph they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright for it.
- 21. Prizes:
 - 1st place in each age category: £25.00 iTunes/Cinema voucher
 - Runner up: £15.00 iTunes/Cinema voucher
- 22. Winners and runners up can choose which type of voucher they would prefer.
