We may need to discuss you or your care with a GP or healthcare professional if we:

- are unable to contact you by your chosen method of communication
- need to provide a test result
- feel there is harm to you or somebody else. This is to help protect your health and wellbeing


## Consent!

Sexual consent means actively agreeing to take part in a sexual activity.

This might be touching kissing, oral sex, vaginal sex or anal sex.

Consent from **both** partners is needed before taking part in any sexual activity.

Doing something sexual to another person without their consent is sexual assault or rape.





### Condoms

The one accessory you can't be without...

- protects against sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and unplanned pregnancy
- free to collect from any of our clinics

## **Emergency contraception**

You can access free emergency contraception from pharmacies across Wirral.

Conditions apply and the pharmacist will decide whether they can see you or whether they need to fast-track you to our clinic. Telephone ahead of attending to check you can be seen.
